**ANALYSIS AND ADVISORY EVALUATION OF REQUEST  
FOR NATIONAL INTEREST WAIVER**

The following is an analysis and advisory evaluation of Felipe Antonio da Silva Pires' request for a National Interest Waiver. The United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) use the following three requirements to evaluate requests for a National Interest Waiver.

- **Requirement 1** - The foreign national's proposed endeavor has both substantial merit and national importance.
- **Requirement 2** - The foreign national is well positioned to advance the proposed endeavor.
- **Requirement 3** - It would be beneficial to the United States to waive the job offer and labor certification requirements.

As discussed herein, I find that Felipe Antonio da Silva Pires meets the three requirements set forth by the USCIS to evaluate national interest requests. In my opinion, it is clearly in the national



interest of the United States to grant him a National Interest Waiver given his impressive record of achievements as a physician. It would be a significant economic loss for the United States to miss the opportunity to benefit from his advanced knowledge and skills in the area of medicine.

The remainder of the letter is structured as follows:

First, I will describe how my academic and professional credentials qualify me to issue an opinion on the appropriateness of granting Felipe Antonio da Silva Pires a National Interest Waiver. Next, I will describe his educational background as well as his work experience in the medical sector. Finally, I will demonstrate that he meets the three requirements set forth by the USCIS to evaluate requests for a National Interest Waiver. A summary of the findings will conclude the letter.

I am providing this opinion letter based on my experience as a podiatric physician and as a Professor of Anatomy/Physiology/Microbiology of the Nursing Department at The Swedish Institute in New York, Adjunct Professor of Human Physiology at SUNY Downstate College of Health-Related Professions and present evaluator-partner of foreign credentials at USCES.

With regard to my academic background, I obtained my Associate of Applied Science degree from Nassau Community College in 1985, a Podiatric Medical Residency certificate from North Port Veterans Hospital in 1992 and a Doctor of Podiatric Medicine degree from New York College of Podiatric Medicine in 1991. In addition to that, I also took a RN Program at Nassau Community College in 2005.

As an evaluator, I am responsible for reviewing academic and experiential qualifications to form part of a candidate's credential evaluation report, providing a detailed analysis of the academic background and occupational experience that a person has received outside the United States.

Through the aforementioned academic and professional experiences, I have developed an expert knowledge on how to analyze, evaluate, and characterize job duties, responsibilities, qualifications, and expertise. Therefore, I believe I am qualified to issue an opinion on the level



and significance of Felipe Antonio da Silva Pires' ability as a physician, as well as to evaluate the appropriateness of granting him a National Interest Waiver.

**Felipe Antonio da Silva Pires will work in an area of substantial merit and national importance.**

As discussed herein, I find that Felipe Antonio da Silva Pires meets the three requirements set forth by the USCIS to evaluate national interest requests. In my opinion, it is clearly in the national interest of the United States to grant him a National Interest Waiver, given his impressive record of achievements as a physician.

With 15 years of professional experience as a Physician, Felipe Antonio da Silva Pires has specialized in Orthopedics and Foot and Ankle Surgery, working in his own clinics and hospitals. **Waiving job offer and labor certification requirements for Felipe Antonio da Silva Pires would be beneficial for the U.S.**





The labor certification process is designed to protect the national interests of the United States by ensuring that the wages and working conditions of U.S. workers employed in the beneficiary's field would not be adversely impacted.

Felipe Antonio da Silva Pires holds several degrees and possesses exceptional skills in the medical field. He has established a proven record of excellence and accomplishments throughout his career. By 2034, it is estimated that the country could face a shortage of up to 124,000 physicians across various specialties. This shortage poses a significant public health crisis, leading to delayed medical care and negative impacts on community health and healthcare costs. Contributing factors to the shortage include an aging population, an increasing number of retiring physicians, declining overall health, and limited access to medical school. Efforts to address the shortage include the use of non-physician care, debt relief programs for high-demand areas, and the option of attending international medical schools. Prompt action is needed to fill these gaps in healthcare provision.

Felipe Antonio da Silva Pires' unique skills and extensive experience enable him to train and mentor students and professionals in the field, thus expanding the workforce in the field. He has the capacity to organize and participate in professional events, including seminars, workshops, congresses, and lectures. In this context, it would be beneficial to the United States to waive the requirements of a job offer and thus of a labor certification due to Felipe Antonio da Silva Pires'



extensive and unique expertise. He has participated in national committees and has greatly contributed to his field. He will provide much needed expertise in the medical sector.

For this reason, Felipe Antonio da Silva Pires' experience is valuable and can be of great benefit to the United States. He also has extensive experience, thus being qualified to train other U.S. professionals in the field.

Because of his demonstrated history in the medical field, it can be affirmed that Felipe Antonio da Silva Pires offers contributions of such value that the United States will benefit from his work, even assuming that other qualified U.S. workers were available.

Furthermore, the implicit opportunity cost of not allowing him to reside in the United States and in order to allow U.S. companies to benefit from his skills and professional experience can be sizable terms of foregone economic activity, national growth, tax revenue, and wellbeing of citizens.

In summary, waiving the job offer and labor certification requirements for Felipe Antonio da Silva Pires is in the national interest of the United States.

## **Conclusion**

It is my opinion that Felipe Antonio da Silva Pires meets the following three requirements set forth by the USCIS to evaluate requests for National Interest Waiver.

He has demonstrated a remarkable record of specific achievements as a physician with an intimate and sophisticated knowledge in the areas of orthopedics and foot and ankle surgery, which is clearly indicative of future benefits to the national interest of the United States.

There are substantial economic benefits for the United States associated with waiving the job offer and labor certification requirements for him, in terms of his activity and job creation that outweigh the national interests in the labor certification process.



Taken together, the evidence demonstrates that it is beneficial to the United States to grant him a National Interest Waiver, given his professional experience as a physician as well as his intimate knowledge and experience in medical services in Brazil.
